Four of central Missouri’s best wineries have recently formed the Missouri River Wine Trail. Les Bourgeois in Rocheport, Summit Lake Winery in Holts Summit and Hartsburg and Native Stone Winery in Jefferson City are the founding partners of this new cooperative effort to promote wineries along the Missouri River.

As one of its first ventures, the Missouri River Wine Trail entities are hosting “Vine and Market,” a taste of the Missouri River Wine Trail. The weekend of November 1 and 2, each winery will have unique and delectable fresh gourmet food and wine pairings. Tickets are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the door and include a tasting at each of the four wineries as well as a souvenir logo glass. John Ferrier, owner of Summit Lake Winery, said he and the other wineries hope to have events like this several times throughout the year.

“This is a great opportunity for people to take a day or two and check out the wineries in central Missouri,” said Ferrier.
